## GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are a great way to support developing talent in Scotland and we are delighted that so many businesses and organisations have signed up to this scheme. We have a range of scholarships for a variety of courses. Each year Perth College Development Trust send out a brochure to potential students describing the scholarships and inviting applications. ## SELECTION PROCESS

The Scholarship brochure is distributed throughout schools and colleges and the wider community. At the end of June our Scholarship Committee interview a shortlist of applications and decide who should be awarded each bursary. In order to receive a scholarship, potential students must have been accepted onto a course at Perth College. If not, then the scholarship would be granted subject to being accepted. Once the students have been chosen the Trust will administer payment to the student as agreed by the benefactor.

## PAYMENT OF FUNDS

All money will be paid into Perth College Development Trust who will administer the scholarship process. For every £1 donated 95p goes directly to supporting scholarships and research programmes. The benefactor will decide how the money will be disbursed, whether in a lump sum or over the duration of the course. Students will be required to produce a short progress report at regular intervals to keep the benefactor informed of their progress. If you do not complete the course you will not be entitled to full payment of the scholarship.
