Looking to the Future

The Aviation industry continues to be adversely affected by the coronavirus pandemic however industry outlook reports expects a return to pre-pandemic levels in the next three to five years therefore now is an ideal time to start your career in the industry.

In the next major phase of the College's history, the Aviation Academy for Scotland (AAS) is being created. The aim of this centre is to train people to meet the needs of the whole aviation industry including air traffic control, pilot, engineering and licensed engineer training.

The first stage of the building feasibility study for the Perth development on our Crieff Road campus has been completed, with initial designs drafted to ensure that the new building will deliver the skills for the future of the aviation industry and other engineering sectors.

It will also allow us, alongside Air Service Training (AST) to develop and expand our international presence and reputation.

In addition to new students in China commencing their studies this year the AAS will give the opportunity to further develop partnerships across the globe.

The AAS project is part of the Tay Cities Deal - a partnership between the UK and Scottish governments along with public and private organisations across Angus, Dundee, Fife and Perth and Kinross that together will invest up to £700 million in projects promoting sustainable and inclusive prosperity for the region.
