Hello everyone, I hope you are all looking forward to a well deserved rest. These past few months have truly flown by!


At this month's SRC meeting we explored potential events and opportunities including increased work placements. There was feedback on campus catering as well as how to improve our current email communications with students.

I am delighted to present my updated campus maps with you all! This should hopefully make it easier to navigate your way around campus!




Brahan Building First Floor

Chinese New Year The Year of the Tiger

The 1st of February 2022 marked the beginning of Chinese New Year, the most important holiday in China which lasts for 16 days and ends with a lantern festival on the 16th.

In China it is often referred to as **"chunjie"** or the Spring Festival. It celebrates the arrival of a new season and the coming harvests, whilst symbolizing new beginnings and opportunities.

The holiday is set in accordance to the Lunar Calendar which means the dates change slightly each year. Each year features a set zodiac animal with 2022 being the Year of the Tiger.

During Chinese New Year children receive lucky red envelopes filled with money to signify fortune transferring from elders to younger generations.
