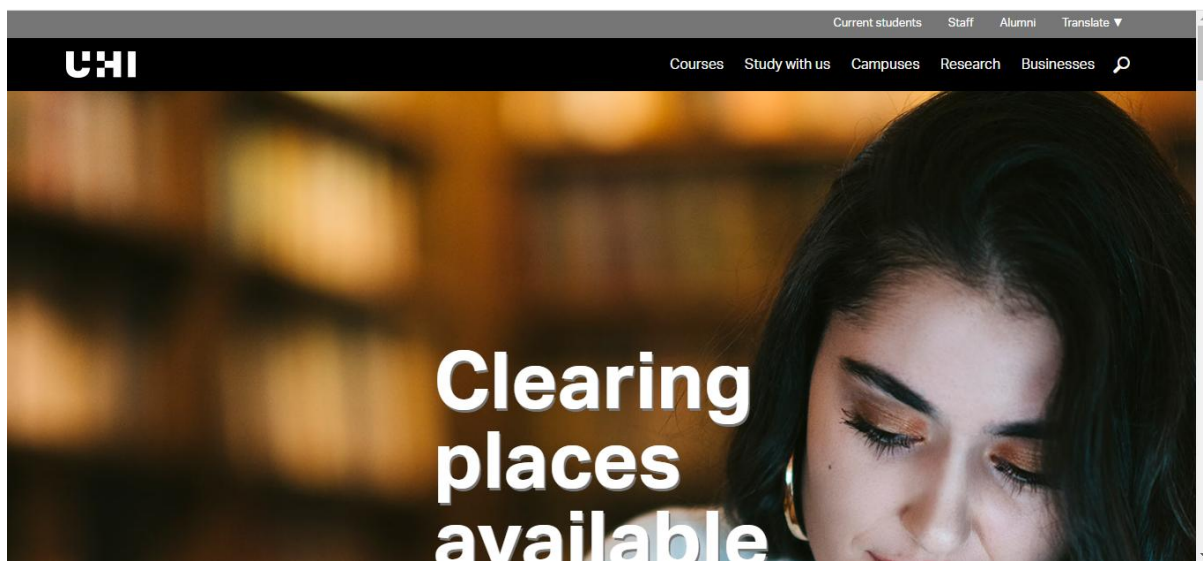

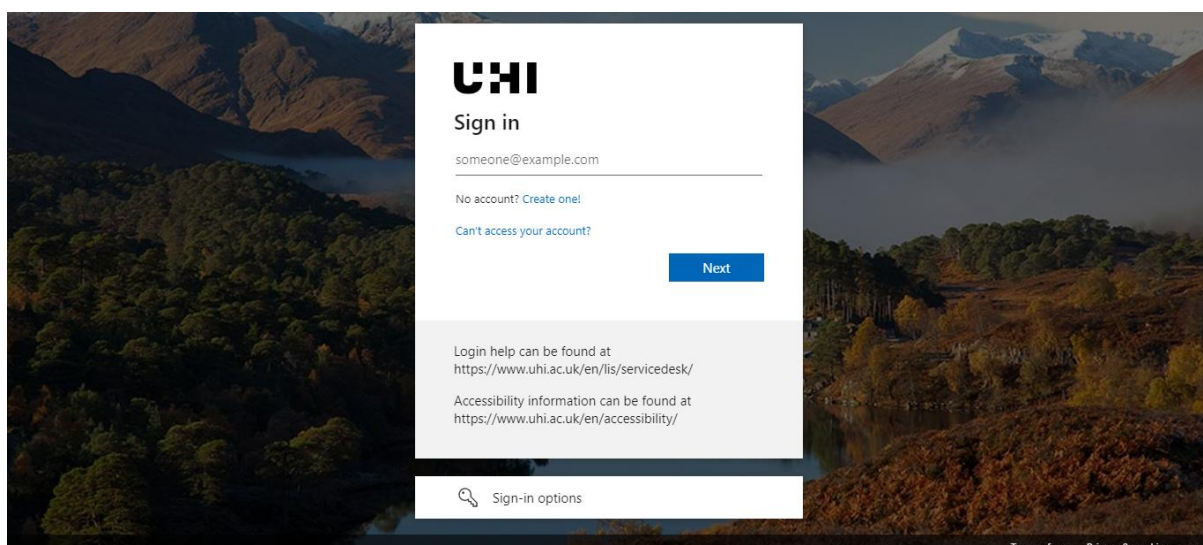

To access your email, the virtual learning environment (Brightspace), library resources etc. please go to the main UHI website <https://www.uhi.ac.uk/en/>:

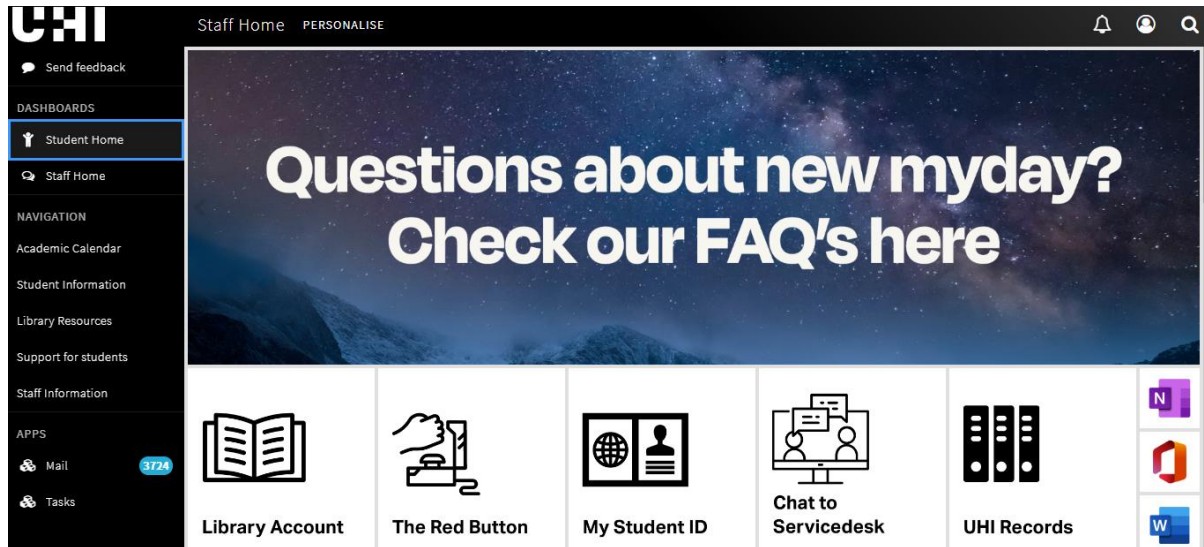


Click on the Current Students tab. This will take you to the following sign in page.

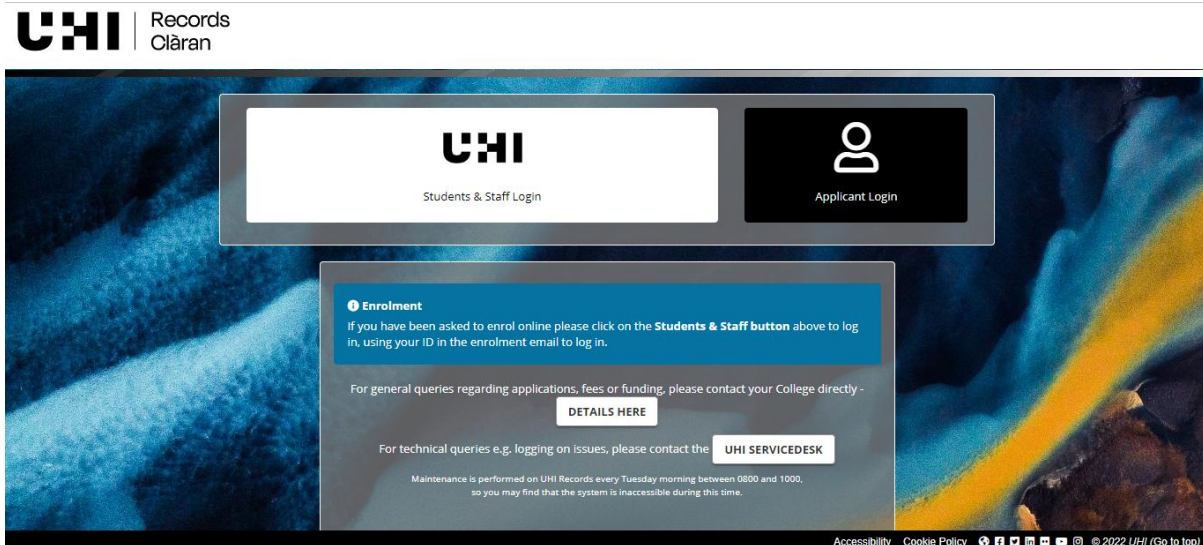

To log on, please use your student ID and your password. You do not need the @uhi.ac.uk to log onto UHI Records e.g. Username: studentID

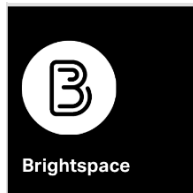

All students will be added to their core modules if taking a full-time or structured part-time route. For Child and Youth Studies, it is important that you select your option modules online to ensure that you can access these modules in the Virtual Learning Environment. 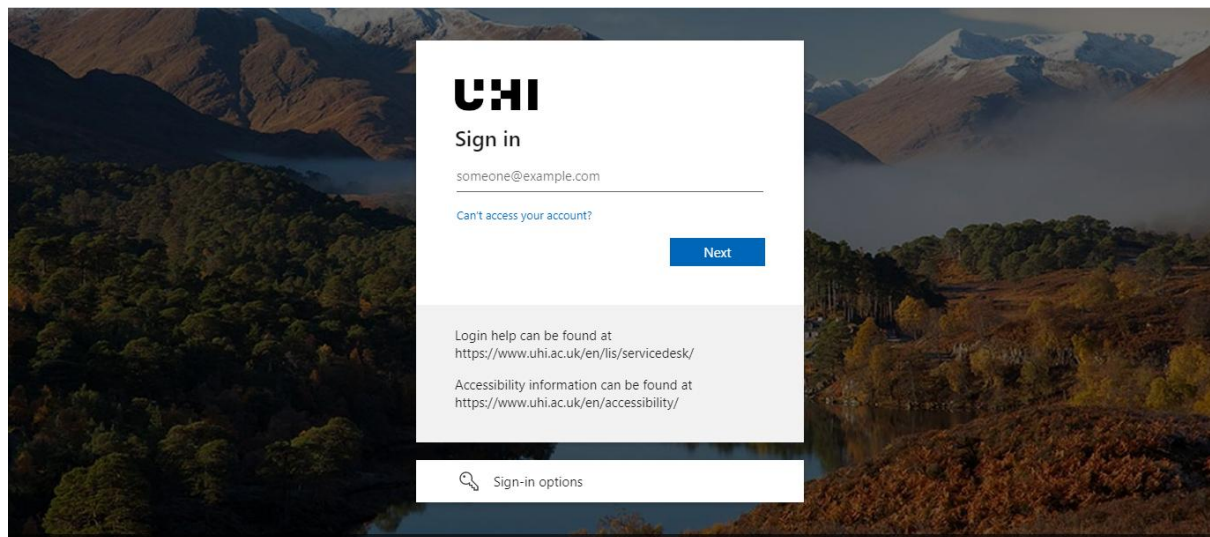

Brightspace (Virtual Learning Environment)

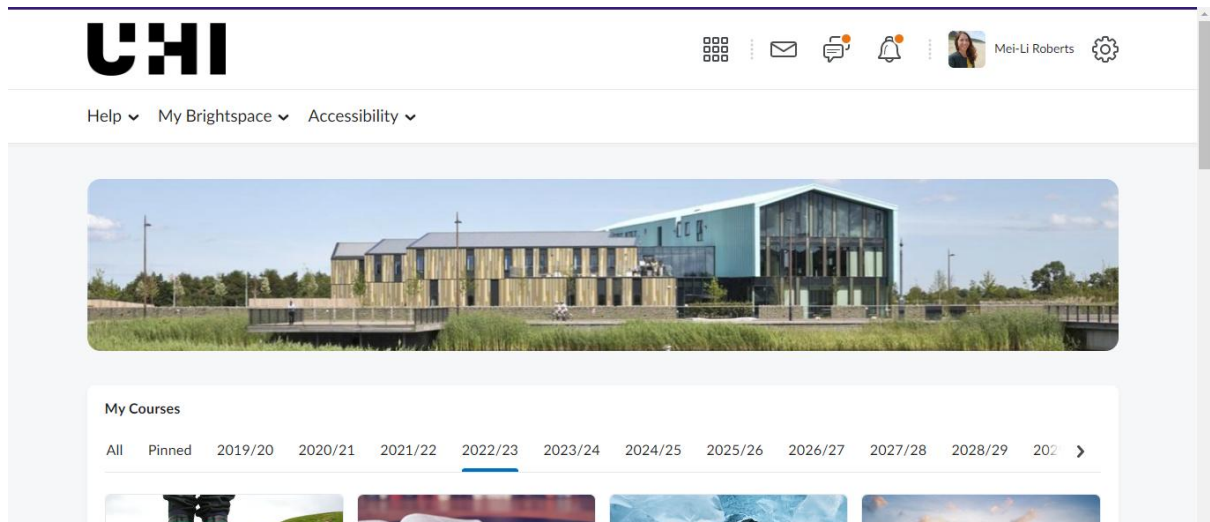
This is where you will access all your modules during your degree study. To get to this, please click on the tab **Brightspace** on the [MyDay](#) portal

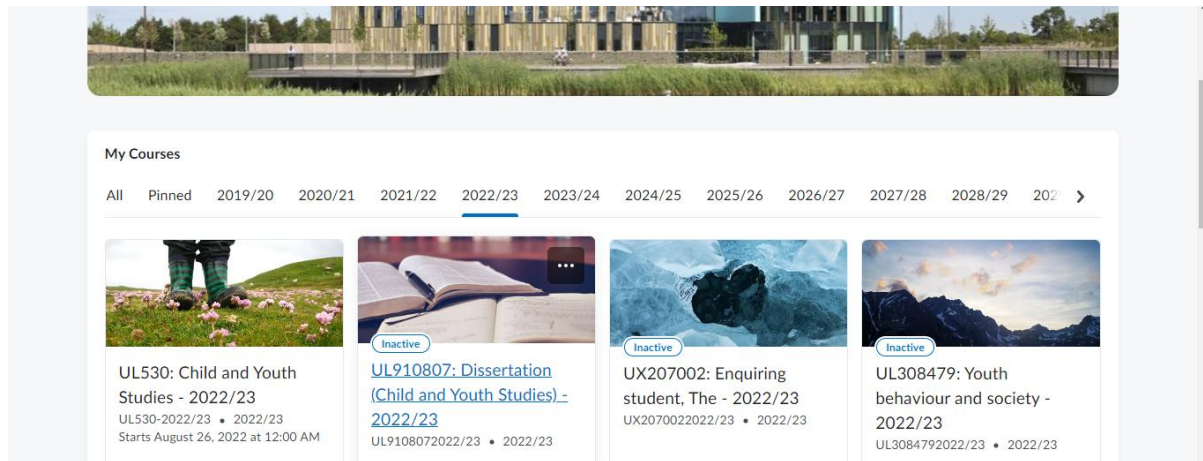

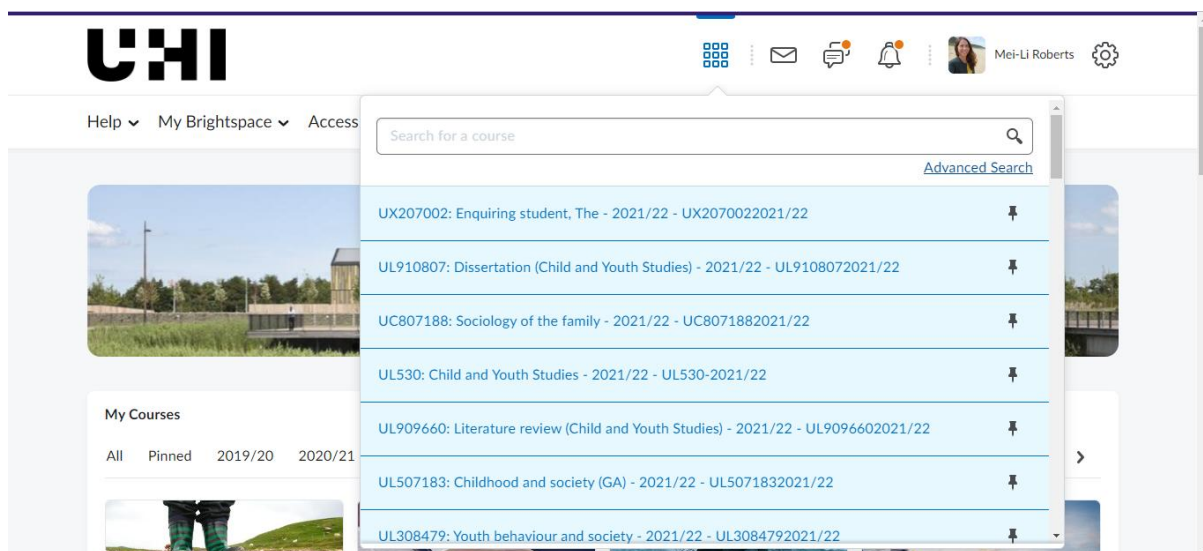


Once you have logged on you will see your home page with the modules you are enrolled on as tiles. Please check that the modules you have selected on [UHI Records](#) for the relevant semester are showing on [Brightspace](#) on the first day of the semester. If any of these are missing, please contact your Personal Academic Tutor. If you are a full-time student, you should see three modules and the programme space UL530: Child and Youth Studies/UL531: Child and Youth Studies with

Community Learning and Development. If you are a part-time student you will see either one module and UL530: Child and Youth Studies / UL531: Child and Youth Studies with Community Learning and Development or two modules and UL530: Child and Youth Studies / UL531: Child and Youth Studies with Community Learning and Development. **Please note:** you may not see the module tiles until the first day of the semester or you may be able to see these, but they are greyed out.



You can also search for your modules using the course drop down – the block of squares at the top.



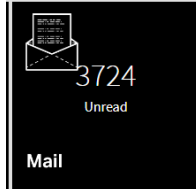

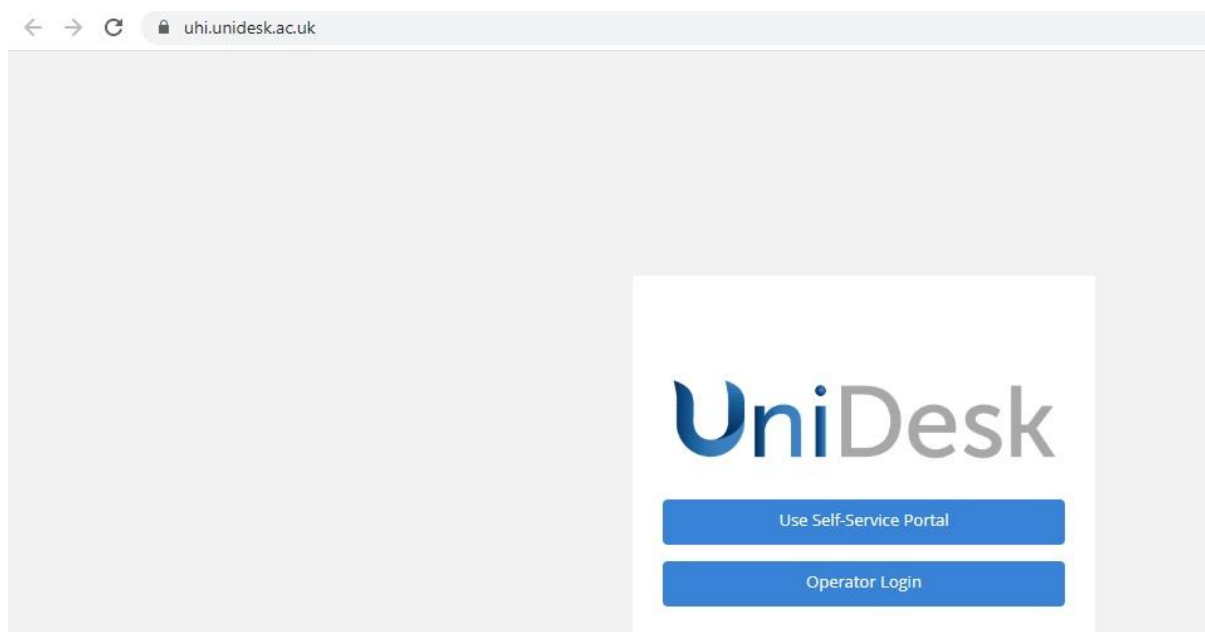
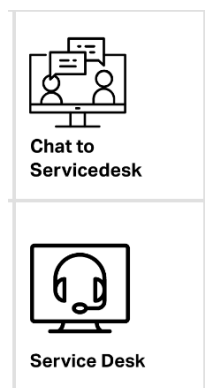
UHI Servicedesk

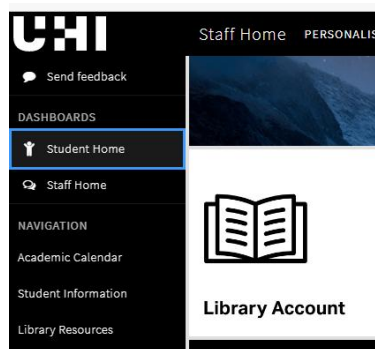

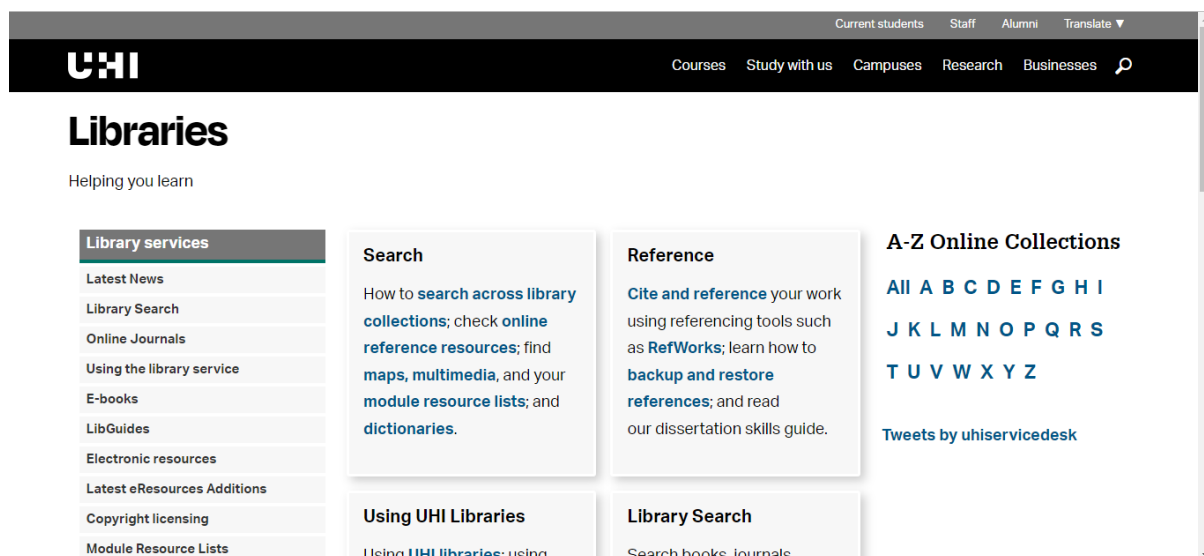
