The University of the Highlands and Islands degrees have been structured to be as flexible as possible for prospective students. The following degrees build on Higher National courses, giving successful students the opportunity to gain valuable qualifications at each stage.

BSh Audio Engineering – Year 2, 3 and 4

BAH Music Business – Year 2, 3 and 4

The HNC (1 year, full time) course represents the first year the Degree course.

Following successful completion of the first year, (plus any other conditions required), you will then automatically transfer into the second year of the degree programme to continue your studies.

The HND (2 years, full-time) course represents the first and second year of the Degree course.

Following successful completion (plus any other conditions required) of the 2 year course, you will then automatically transfer into the third year of the degree programme to continue your studies.
